The YCSO constitution and its establishment has been approved at a YAC board meeting held 17 December 2024.

Initial directors have been appointed as a temporary measure to have the company registered.

We are now seeking passionate and dedicated leaders to join an exciting opportunity to drive meaningful and lasting improvements in the social and well-being outcomes of the Yinhawangka People. It is essential that the board represents all apical groups to ensure inclusive and balanced decision-making.

- can provide information about experience/expertise they have in:
 - corporate governance
 - communication
 - leadership; and
 - strategic planning and implementation

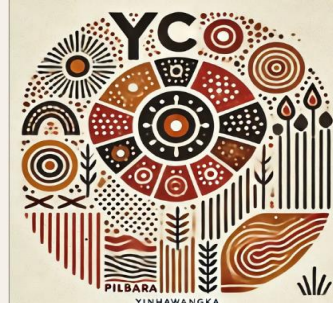

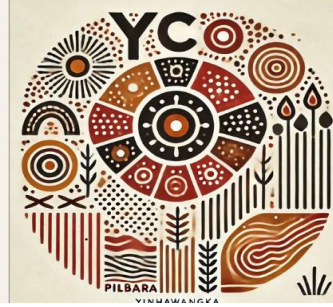
